Fonasba Quality Standard

Criteria for its implementation and for acknowledging the partners from the Peruvian Association of Maritime Agents - APAM

Minimum Requirements to Obtain the Fonasba Quality Standard

- ✓ Having been a full APAM member for no less than three (3) years.
- ✓ Submitting a commitment note signed by the company's General Manager or Attorney stating its commitment to abide by FONASBA's Code of Conduct and the Association's Byelaws.
- ✓ Submitting the company's byelaws with the corresponding registration in the Corporation Registry of the National Public Registry Superintendence (SUNARP).
- ✓ Submitting a copy of the Board of Directors' meeting minutes with duly registered appointment of positions that is current in the Corporation Registry of the National Public Registry Superintendence (SUNARP).
- Showing evidence of the Company's registration and of having a current operation code before the National Deputy Customs Superintendence, National Port Authority (APN) and General Captainship and Coastguard Directorate of Peru (DICAPI).
- ✓ Showing evidence of commitment with quality processes through an ISO or another similar certification, mentioning the three certification areas.
- At the end of every tax, submit a Certificate issued by the external auditor of the company, with valid fellowship at the Accountants' Guild of Lima, establishing that:
 - a) The Company follows Peru's accounting procedures and regulations.
 - b) The Company keeps separate accounts for each one of its main authorities,
 - c) The Company complies with every tax and pension obligation, and
 - d) A financial report to the association's satisfaction.
- ✓ Submitting current taxpayer number before the National Tax Administration Superintendence (SUNAT).

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- ✓ Submitting a copy of the Insurance Policy issued by ITIC or any other internationally acknowledged Insurance Mutual, Club or Company.
- ✓ Submitting a list of the staff members specifying their professional qualifications (line managers, operation managers, attorneys, etc.) and those of anyone authorized to represent the company before SUNAT, APN and DICAPI.
- ✓ Submitting an affidavit that states the company's personnel training policy, plus a copy of the annual training programs.
- ✓ Every two (02) years, the companies will be subject to a compliance audit by APAM regarding the established requirements to certify the Fonasba Quality Standard (FQS).
